STANDING ORDERS

JUNE 2014

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These Standing Orders were created for the Brede Parish Council in June 2014 and were based on the Model Standing Orders produced by the National Association of Local Councils (NALC) in 2010.

Standing Orders in **bold type** reflect statutory requirements and should not be amended unless the legislation out of which they are born changes.

Standing Orders not highlighted in bold type, do not incorporate statutory requirements and have been adapted from the NALC model to meet Brede's particular requirements. They are aimed at (i) highlighting matters that merit regulation by standing orders and (ii) encouraging use of standing orders to regulate routine administrative arrangements.

It is recommended by NALC that local councils should undertake a review of their standing orders annually.
